- Camp is for children who attend an area school and are between the ages 5-12 years old. Children must have completed K in the 2015-2016 school year to register.

Reading Sessions I & II: 12:30 - 3:30 p.m.

The reading camps are designed to help children who are reluctant and struggling readers improve literacy skills and become more confident students. However, the camp offers an opportunity to enrich reading skills for those who do not require intervention. Each child is helped to read books of their choosing and encouraged to develop a love of learning. Children receive personal attention in a "failure-free" setting. Skills that help children become better and more confident readers are emphasized.

Undergraduate students attending TAMU-CC serve as teachers for the camp.

Camp participants work in small groups, where they experience writing, pleasure reading, phonics, encoding and decoding, reading comprehension and other reading strategies that accommodate various learning styles.
